Please contact us if you would like to enter a Progeny Group – Entry Fee to be confirmed.

\* £200 is paid when entering the class and covers the licence for the first season (2011) under the condition that the licence is awarded. £200 is payable by 1/8-2012 if the owner wishes to make further use of the licence (still under the condition that the license has been awarded). The limited license under the pure bred programme is valid for a maximum of 10 registered offspring.

**General Rules of Entry:**

1. Entries can only be submitted in writing on the KSGB KNN Grading entry form for the KSGB KNN Knabstrupper grading. All fields on the entry form must be completed. Only one horse to be entered per entry form.
2. **Closing date for entries is 31<sup>st</sup> August 2010.** Entries must be sent to Annabel Firmin, Leitfie House, Alyth, Blairgowrie, Perthshire, PH11 8NZ accompanied by a cheque for the relevant fees due made payable to “Knabstrupper Society GB Ltd”. Please write the horse’s name and registration number on the back of the cheque. Entry fees will only be returned if the owner produces a vet’s certificate. An admin fee of £25 and any applicable registration fees incurred by the society will be deducted.
3. Late entries may be accepted where practicable, but cannot be guaranteed. Listing in the grading programme and stabling cannot be guaranteed. Entry for stallions less



than 6 weeks prior to the grading will only be accepted when the owner is in receipt of a DNA profile. Please enquire.

4. Remember to include a request for any stable hire – it is £15 (incl. VAT) per day for each horse (or mare/foal share) and should be paid directly to the venue on the day. Horses requiring stabling must be fully vaccinated. Stabling is strictly limited, so is allocated on a first come first served basis.
5. Owners must be members of the KSGB or the KNN to put a horse forward for grading. If the owner is not currently a KSGB or KNN member, please fill in the Membership form and submit with the correct funds for the membership fee (£45) along with the grading entry form.
6. Only the registered owner of the animal has the right to enter it to shows run by the KNN. Change of ownership can be done in connection with the grading at a special reduced fee of £10.
7. Original papers or photocopies of these, i.e. passport or original stud book must be enclosed with entries for all classes. If photocopies are enclosed, the original papers must be presented on the day of the grading. Adult horses for grading who do not hold KNN or other papers issued under Landscentret Heste must be registered on Landscentret Heste's database. The registration for mares and geldings can be arranged at the grading. Stallions must be registered on the database when presented at the grading. Allow at least 14 days for the registration to take place. Original papers have to be sent to Landscentret Heste in Denmark for verification. A one off registration fee of £45 applies.
8. The horse's owner can choose which standard (Sports Horse or Classical) the horse should be assessed according to. Horses can be evaluated according to both standards at the owner's request. A reduced fee of 50% of the normal entry fee will apply for a second standard evaluation. If the owner would like guidance which standard to choose, the box "Guidance sought" must be ticked.
9. DNA testing of stallions and foals, and DNA profiling of mares is obligatory. Stallions **must** have their DNA result available at the time of the grading. A DNA kit can be supplied to the stallion owner prior to the grading; mares and foals can have hair taken at the grading. If DNA is required, a fee of £47 must be enclosed with the entry form.
10. Hair can be taken for the DNA test by personnel at the grading at no additional cost.
11. The KNN has the right to cancel any events or classes if there are not enough entries.
12. Participation is done so at own risk. The KNN cannot be made responsible for any loss, damage or injury directly or indirectly sustained in connection with the event.
